

The Divine Call

When Jesus called His first disciples, He picked the ones He desired, they came to Him, and He appointed them to be His apostles whom He would send out to preach. (Mark 3:13-14) We call this the *Divine Call* because Jesus the Divine God is calling men into the office of the holy ministry. We call this an *Immediate Call* because Jesus is immediately beside the man and personally calling him. Jesus taps him on the shoulder and says, "Come, follow me."

But what about after Jesus ascended into heaven and was no longer visible on earth? How would God continue to call men into the holy ministry? We have an example in Acts chapter 1. After Judas despaired and killed himself, the twelve apostles were short a man. Peter stood up among the believers and reasoned that another must fill his office to complete the office of apostleship. How was this to be done? The Church first sought candidates who were qualified for the office. The qualifications were that the candidate must have been a witness of Jesus' ministry during the three years from His baptism to His resurrection and ascension. The Church put forward two such candidates, Justus and Matthias, and then prayed, "You, Lord, who know the hearts of all, show which one of these two *You have chosen* to take the place in this ministry and apostleship." They cast lots, the lot fell to Matthais, and he was numbered with the apostles. What does it mean to cast lots? It can mean to cast special stones, like dice, and then allow the Lord to show His will, His yes or no, through those means. Casting lots can also mean to elect by a show of

hands, sort of like a voters' meeting. The Lord is showing His will and desire through the means of the congregation. Now this is still a Divine Call since God is doing the choosing; however, we call this a *Mediated Call* since God is calling through the means of His Church.

The Lord will use these same means to call the next pastor at Trinity Darmstadt through the means of His Church. The congregation will put forth names and submit qualifications to the Indiana District President. President Rev. Dr. Stuckwisch will supply a list of candidates to the call committee – the board of elders. Guided by our Circuit Visitor, Rev. David Wiist, the call committee will select qualified candidates to put before the voters' assembly. The voters could roll some dice to determine God's will, but most likely there will be a vote by a show of hands or a written ballot. Whatever the method, the Lord is showing which candidate He has chosen to be the next pastor at Trinity. It is still a Divine Call because the Divine is doing the calling. God is simply using the means of His Church.

In the days of the apostles, there may have been some in the congregation who preferred Justus over Matthais because he was a better orator or better looking, but there was no dispute after the lot was cast. The congregation recognized that the Lord knows the heart and was choosing through the means of His Church. The vote was final. In the same way, the members of Trinity Darmstadt might have a preference for different, qualified candidates; however, after the vote is completed, the congregation recognizes that the result is God's Divine Call for the elected candidate to serve as Trinity's next pastor. God has decided and chosen your new shepherd.

My last Sunday to serve as Trinity's pastor will be April 16. Please do not think of me as a Judas who left his office in despair. Rather I have received God's Divine Call to serve the saints at Heritage Lutheran in Valparaiso. While I may have personal preferences to remain at Trinity, I also recognize God's will and desire for the holy ministry in His time and place.

Thank you for the last eight years of serving as your pastor at Trinity Darmstadt. Linda and I have been so blessed to serve those who have served and guided us in our life in the Church and in this world. God bless you and keep you until we meet again here on earth and certainly in heaven. The Lord be with you all.
